MINUTES OF ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING

Date: January 11, 2025

Time: 12:00 Noon

Venue: KV Hebbal, Bangalore

The Annual General Body Meeting (AGM) of the KV Hebbal Alumni Association (KVHAA) was called to order by the President, Dr. Alice Abraham, at 12:00 noon.

Agenda and Proceedings

1. Quorum and Reconvening

As per the attendance register, 110 registered members were present, failing to meet the minimum quorum of one-third of the total members, as required by Para 7(a) of the KVHAA byelaws. Consequently, the meeting was adjourned for one hour. Upon reconvening, the quorum requirement of 50 members was fulfilled, and the meeting proceeded.

2. Honoring Our Departed Friends

The meeting began with a two-minute silence in remembrance of members who had passed away.

3. Welcome Address by the President, KVHAA

Dr. Alice Abraham, President, KVHAA, warmly welcomed Mr. Anand Prakash Semwal, Principal of KV Hebbal and Ex-Officio Chairman of KVHAA, former teachers, Executive Committee (EC) members, the Alumni Coordinator, and all General Body (GB) members present.

In her address, Dr. Abraham highlighted that following the last AGM in February 2024—where crucial changes were made to the KVHAA byelaws—the interim EC, which took charge on February 4, 2024, worked diligently to administer KVHAA and successfully conduct elections in a transparent and efficient manner.

She outlined the key achievements during the term of the current EC, which lasted less than a year:

- Filing and securing approval of the amended byelaws, thereby strengthening the association's foundation.
- Conducting KVHAA's first transparent elections, allowing alumni from around the world to participate in electing their EC.
- Streamlining membership processes to promote greater inclusivity.

- Launching WhatsApp communities and Special Interest Groups (SIGs) to enhance alumni engagement.
- Initiating both online and offline programs to connect and engage alumni beyond Bangalore.
- Holding regular monthly EC meetings to ensure consistent progress.
- Revamping the KVHAA website to improve the user experience.

Dr. Abraham thanked her team for their dedication in meeting alumni expectations despite being an interim body. She expressed deep appreciation for Vice President Ms. Sadhana Majumdar, Secretary Ms. Sunita Haridas, Joint Secretary Mr. S. Parthasarathy, and Treasurer Dr. Sangeetha Natarajan for their unwavering commitment. She also extended gratitude to Core Committee members—Mr. Jagadish, Mr. P. Ramesh Chander, Mr. Gurdeep, and the late Mr. Premchand—for their teamwork and continuous support.

Acknowledging the trust and participation of the General Body, she credited them for KVHAA's resilience through challenges. Wishing the incoming EC well, she emphasized the democratic nature of their election and urged members to stand united in upholding KVHAA's core values.

4. Address by the Principal & Ex-Officio Chairman, KVHAA

Mr. Anand Prakash Semwal congratulated the new office bearers on their election. He expressed his hopes for productive engagement between the association and the school and outlined key areas of concern for the association to address.

5. Report of the Secretary, KVHAA

Ms. Sunita Haridas, Secretary, KVHAA, presented the Secretary's Report, summarizing the following activities of the past year:

- Increasing alumni membership by over 33% in just last year, while emphasizing the need to further engage more alumni.
- Formation of Special Interest Groups (SIGs), including:
 - KVHAA Karaoke Nights (KKN), Business Connect, Sports & Fitness, Career Connectors, Travel & Adventure, Healthcare & Wellness, Book Club & Literature, Environment & Sustainability, and Social Impact.
 - Notable progress was made by KKN and Business Connect.
- Filing the amended byelaws with the Registrar of Societies.
- Launching the KVHAA website at www.kvhalumni.com.
- Facilitating alumni donations for various KVHAA initiatives.
- Ensuring the annual renewal of registration with the Registrar of Societies/Associations.

6. Report of the Treasurer

Dr. Sangeetha Natarajan, Treasurer, KVHAA, presented the financial statements for FY 2023-24, which included the balance sheet, income and expenditure statement, and receipt and payment statement.

7. Nomination of Secretary, KVHAA

The Election Convener noted that no nominations were received for the position of Secretary, KVHAA. The President invited nomination from the General Body to fill this important position.

- Mr. N. Mohan proposed Mr. S. Parthasarathy for the position, seconded by Ms. Sadhana Majumdar.
- The General Body unanimously nominated Mr. S. Parthasarathy as Secretary, KVHAA.

8. Address by the Alumni Coordinator

Ms. H.R. Shyamala, Alumni Coordinator, PMShri KVH expressed her appreciation for the KVHAA association's work in supporting the school and encouraged the new EC to strengthen ties with the school.

9. Vote of Thanks

Ms. Sadhana Majumdar, Vice President, KVHAA, expressed her gratitude to all General Body members for their participation, the outgoing EC for their dedicated efforts, and the newly elected EC for stepping up to lead the association. She thanked Dr. Alice Abraham for her leadership, the Principal & Ex-Officio Chairman for his support, and the Secretary and Treasurer for their contributions. She also acknowledged the organizing team and volunteers for ensuring the smooth conduct of the AGM. She concluded by urging everyone to stay united in strengthening the alumni network and wished the new EC success in their journey ahead.
